

2019 Riesling Bernkastel Cueser-Weisenstein Trocken

Alcohol: 12.50 vol%

Residual Sugar: 3.10 g/L

Acidity: 7.10 g/L

Vineyard: Bernkastel-Cueser Weisenstein

Variety: Riesling

Story: In this south west facing vineyard Riesling vines are standing on bridle clay slate. Until the evening this vineyard is exposed to the sun. This and the deep soil give power, full aromas, and a soft acidity structure to the wine.

Vinification: The grapes for this wine are strongly selected, only minimal amounts of botrytis are tolerated. At harvest the grapes are fully ripened, golden and have a soft acidity. In a 1000L used oak barrel the wine undergoes a natural fermentation until it reaches the dry stage. Due to the oak and regular bâtonnage during the lee aging this wine will show an unusual creamy character.
