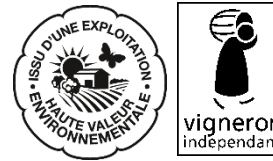


Château VERMONT

In 1874, Feret's third edition had already revealed Château Vermont as one of the top growths of the Entre deux Mers appellation.

This vineyard makes up today's 40 hectares of vines planted encircling this XVIII century castle.

Since 2010, we work to extract the best of its 'terroir' and restore this property to all its former glory.

Winemaking

Maceration	: a cold skin soaking
Pressing	: direct pressing to low pressure
Fermentation T°	: less than 16°
Vinification	: Vinification integrale in oak barrels of 500 liters
Temperature control	: yes
Aging	: in new barrels during 12 months on fine lees
Alcohol	: 12,50% vol
Consulting winemaker	: Claude Gros

Tasting Characteristics

Traditional blend of « Grand Vin Blanc de Bordeaux ».

A rare and confidential wine, vinified and matured in barrels.

Fine wine, elegant and well-balanced; dominated by Sauvignon (fruitiness), with vanilla notes coming from barrels. This wine has beautiful structure and very long-lasting aromas and tastes, giving it interesting cellaring
