ABOUT CHAVY-CHOUET

Owner Romaric Chavy, who took over the estate in 2014, is the eighth generation to make wine in his family. Romaric learned from his father, Hubert Chavy, who founded the winery in 1982. Chavy-Chouet is one of the oldest families in Puligny-Montrachet. The Ropiteau family (on his mother's side) is the oldest one in Meursault.

Chavy-Chouet is a 15 hectare-domaine (37 acres) that produces wine from 14 A.O.C.'s (80% White, 20% Red). The vineyard is divided into 70 parcels planted to vines that are 40 years old or more.

ABOUT THE WINE

The "Les Vireuils" parcel is located on the top of the hill above Meursault (highest elevation), right below the forest. It is a slightly cooler parcel with a limestone soil and a higher presence of rocks.

"The 2018 Meursault Les Vireuils has a lovely nose of menthol-tinged citrus fruit that gains intensity with aeration. The palate is very well balanced with well-judged acidity, vivid orange zest and citrus notes and a precise, mineral-driven finish. This is a superb Les Vireuils." - Neal Martin
