ABOUT DOMAINE CORNE-LOUP

The Lafond family purchased 3 hectares in Tavel in 1966. Today, Jacques Lafond runs the winery with help from his daughter & winemaker, Géraldine Saunier. Their vineyards now cover 42 hectares (in Tavel, Lirac and Côtes-du-Rhône), with an annual production around 20,000 9-liter cases.

"Corne Loup" is the name given to this part of the Tavel village, where, in olden times, someone would blow the horn ("corne") in order to warn others of a sighting of a wolf ("loup") coming into town.

ABOUT THE WINE

This Côtes-du-Rhône comes from vines 40 years old on average, with the oldest of the group 80-year-old. Dark ruby color with aromas of red berries, truffles and spices. Rich, complex flavors of black fruits with spicy garrigue & bold tannins.
