



## KENNEDY POINT SAUVIGNON BLANC

### New Zealand - Marlborough

#### ABOUT THE WINERY

Kennedy Point Vineyard is tucked among the Pohutukawa trees overlooking Waiheke Island's Kennedy Bay. The winery was established in 1996, with its first harvest in 1999. Kennedy Point is named for the Kennedy family who settled the area of Waiheke in the late 1800's and who still have an ancestral home on the island today.

The wine produced on this property reflects the essence of the land, supporting the team philosophy that great wine happens in the vineyard. Organic viticulture aims to sustain and enhance the fertility and life-supporting ability of the soil by not using chemical fertilizers and sprays. Kennedy Point is fully organic certified as of August 2010.

Kennedy Point has 5 hectares, planted to Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir & Syrah. Annual production is around 2,000 cases per year.

#### ABOUT THE WINE

Kennedy Point's Sauvignon Blanc captures the essence of the regional fruit. The grapes, grown in the hot, stony soils of the Wairau, produce a wine redolent of fresh cut wildflowers and a full palate of passion fruit, gooseberry and citrus. Crushed and pressed in stainless steel fermenters to preserve the vibrant aromatics and fruit, then fermented slowly at cool temperature to maintain freshness.

Varietal(s)	100% Sauvignon Blanc
Agricultural Practices	Organic
Vinification	Fermented with wild yeast & aged on the lees, to enhance the complexity and unique qualities of the terroir. No oak.
Food pairings	The wine has a crisp dry finish and is perfect as an aperitif, with seafood or any light summer meal.
