ABOUT THE WINERY

Domaine Roche Redonne, founded in 1979, is a family-owned winery run by Henri and Geneviève Tournier. Guilhem, the son, is involved in the winemaking process.

The property is located on the foothills of the Bandol appellation, along the Mediterranean Coast, in the town of La Cadière d'Azur. It is surrounded by olive trees and garrigue (wild herbs).

The 12-hectare vineyard is farmed under organic methods. Both Henri and Geneviève focus on the work in the vineyard in respect of the environment. The vines are 40 years old on average, with the youngest vines at 20 years and the oldest at 60 years. The yields are very low, and the steep hilled vineyards can only be harvested by hand.

ABOUT THE WINE

Nice light salmon color, typical of Bandol. The nose expresses some citrus, Pomelos (a delicious type of grapefruit), lots of white fruit aromas and minerality. The flavors are fresh, fruity, with tons of apricot and mango.
