Our Ameritage (AMerican hERITAGE) does something very few wines do; blending 4 different Bordeaux varietals, all grown in Virginia, to create a truly complex and unique blend. It is our largest produced wine, and our most requested.



Blend/ Varietal Notes

42% Cabernet Sauvignon, 26% Merlot, 21% Cabernet Franc and 11% Petit Verdot. 542 cases made of our signature wine.

Winemaking

Wines are aged as varietals in new and neutral American oak for 10 months. Each year, we decide the blend based on how the individual varietals react and combine with each other. Once chosen, barrels are combined for additional aging and bottled after 14 months, adding to the wine's complexity.

Tasting Notes

On the nose, we get baking spices with notes of cassis. The palate, there are notes of earthy sour cherry, with black tea. The wine is fruit forward and rich throughout. It has an aging potential of 7 -10 years.

Vineyards Sourced

Toll Gate Vineyard in Rappahannock County, Silver Creek Vineyard in Nelson County and Mt. Juliet Vineyard in Albemarle County.
