ABOUT THE WINERY

Bodega San Gregorio is a cave co-op founded in 1965. It is located in the Ribota River Valley, some 30 kilometers (20 miles) north of the city of Calatayud. It belongs to the Calatayud D.O., created in 1989. The coop cultivates 2,200 acres of primarily Garnacha (70%) and Tempranillo (20%), with some white Macabeo and other varieties. Most of the vines are at least 40 years old; some over 50 years. The vines, planted "en vaso" (head-trained), are not irrigated, offering very low production levels. Local soils are rich in limestone, marl and slate.

ABOUT THE WINE

Our Tres Ojos – “three eyes” – is named after an ancient walking bridge in the city of Calatayud. The bridge’s three arches earned it the nickname ‘tres ojos’.



This Garnacha is whole berry fermented, like a Cotes du Rhone Rouge. It displays a brick red color with a bouquet of red raspberries, spice and white pepper. The palate is incredibly concentrated and rich. Fruity and juicy with a great depth, ripe tannins & length, yet wonderful elegance and lightness.

Varietal(s)	85% Old Vine Garnacha and 15% Tempranillo
Vinification	Fermentation at 30 degrees C for 7 days, followed by 14 days skin maceration. Aged 12 months in large stainless steel vats. Cold stabilized and lightly filtered before bottling.
