It's more backward and tight at the moment, yet has classic black fruits, charcoal, and graphite notes, with plenty of oak. I like its mid-palate, and it's nicely concentrated, yet the cellar will be your friend on this one."

"Fermented and aged in wood, this wine is full of spiciness as well as solid, dark fruits. At this stage, the tannins are dominant with a sense of power. However, the wine is also rich with dark plums and blackberries, cut with acidity. It needs to age further, so drink from 2022. - Roger Voss"
