The wine is sourced from the most Northern area of the Barossa and featuring a vibrant purple hue. The nose is lifted with perfumed blueberry and satsuma plum evident. The palate is full bodied and rich with layers of blue fruits, Christmas spices and subtle complex French oak.

Vinification	Harvested from the St Kitts vineyard at night, the fruit was then destemmed into 4 & 6 tonne fermenters where primary fermentation occurred for a period of 7 days on skins. The wine was then pressed off and filled to a combination of 10 year old French and American oak for 18 months. The wine was racked prior to bottling with no filtration or fining.
