

Bastgen Berncastel-Cueser Weisenstein Riesling Spatlese Trocken

Germany - Mosel

In this south west facing vineyard Riesling vines are planted on bridge clay slate. The full day of sun exposure combined with the deep soils result in a powerful wine with layers of aromas, soft acidity and structure. Bright, clean, fresh and zesty. Grapefruit like flavors and minerality that is typical of the Riesling grape grown on blue slate soil. Round, rich and a very long finish.

Varietals	100% Riesling
Age of Vines	50 years
Soil type	Slate
Vinification	The grapes are strongly selected, only minimal amounts of botrytis are tolerated. At harvest the grapes are fully ripened, are gold in color and a soft acidity. In a 1000L used oak barrel the wine undergoes a natural fermentation until it reaches the dry stage. Due to the oak and regular bâtonnage during the lee aging the wine will show an unusual creamy character.
