Atomium PGC is produced under exclusive license in Ertvelde, Belgium, at the brewery Van Steenberge. The brewery itself has been in operation since 1784; it went through a major overhaul in 1992 and is now one of the most advanced breweries in Belgium. The beer is named after the national monument of Belgium - very fitting for a country that considers beer one of its greatest national treasures.



The beer is produced from 6 grains and is one of the only 6 grain top fermented golden ales in the world. The brewmaster uses only the finest malted barley varieties and choicest hops that are designed for high temperature fermentation.

Atomium is brewed with soft water from a private spring, which guarantees extraordinary purity. The rests of oranges from the island of Curacao and coriander seeds leave the beer lover with a full-bodied, balanced flavour palette.

The beer won a gold medal in the 2004 world beer cup hosted in Chicago.
