

2015 Merlot, Columbia Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - The deeply expressive nose is intricate and alluring. Rich notes of blackberry coulis, star anise and cardamom entwine with the savory perfume of rosemary. A firmly structured palate invokes notes of bramble, black huckleberry and sweet tobacco. Young and tightly wound, decanting reveals a voluptuous layer of dark fruits. These intricacies will only become more harmonious with time.
