Anne Delaroche is an exclusive label created for Kysela Pere et Fils by Les Grands Chais de France. The Côtes du Rhône wines are produced at Clos des Miran, located in the plains of Mas Conil, near the village Pont Saint Esprit in the Gard district. The property is located on a hillside of very deep loamy and sandy soil, and the land is tilled with horse-drawn plows to preserve its essential qualities. The estate is certified organic in France since the 2014 vintage.

Charming pale rosé color. The wine displays fresh fruit aromas of strawberry and watermelon. The palate is focused and well balanced, showing more strawberry and ripe red fruit flavors. Long and pleasant finish with a hint of spiciness.
