ABOUT THE WINERY

Founded in 1862, Casir dos Santos is one of the oldest wineries still operating in Argentina. The winery produces wine from the Uco Valley, Lujan de Cuyo and Maipu. Their Lujan de Cuyo vineyard, in Argentina's oldest viticultural area, is at 3,100 feet above sea level.

Casir dos Santos wines are made by head winemaker Fernando Ottaviani and world-renowned winemaker and consultant Didier Debono. Didier consults and makes wine for several wineries in Argentina and Chile, including Kysela's Chilean producer, Siegel Family Wines.

ABOUT THE WINE

The youngest line from Casir dos Santos, Avatar is the embodiment of the Agrelo's terroir in a wine. Striking, audacious, joyful, profound. A spontaneous and pleasurable experience for the senses.

Bright ruby color. Ripe fruit aromas and flavors. Sweet tannins with balanced acidity; pleasing freshness.
