ABOUT LES COSTIERES DES POMEROLS

Founded in 1932, this Cave Coopérative is located in the top commune of Pomérols, between the garrigue of Pezenas and the sea dominated by the Mont St Clair in Sète. The members control 1,200 hectares (2,964 acres) of vineyard land, of which 330 hectares is Picpoul de Pinet. The Pomerols vineyards stretch over vast sun-drenched terraces of clay/calcareous soils. They produce Piquepoul, Chardonnay, Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc, Terret, Merlot, Cabernet, Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault and Carignan.

ABOUT THE WINE

The wine originates from some of the best terroir, selected for its physical and geographical characteristics: clay and limestone hillsides called *costières*, just a few miles away from the Etang de Thau - a coastal lagoon that is situated between the port of Sète and Marseillan.

The color is a beautifully luminous pink. The nose is expressive and clean with fruity notes. The mouthfeel is seductive and well balanced - silky, elegant, crisp and refreshing.
