ABOUT THE WINERY

Siegel Family wines was founded by Alberto Siegel Sr. and his father, viticulturist Don German, in 1980. They began planting vineyards in the Colchagua valley and building a winery in Santa Cruz, and for the first 16 years sold bulk wine to the biggest Chilean wineries. Alberto entered the bottled wine business in 1997, and today the winery produces 250,000 9-liter cases annually.

The Colchagua valley is located in the Central Zone of Chile. It is a 'Transverse Valley", which means that it is a valley formed by a river, in this case the Tinguiririca, running east-to-west towards the ocean. The valley cuts out at a ridge or mountain at right angles. The Colchagua valley is the leading fine-wine producing region in Chile. Today Viña Siegel has 700 acres planted amongst vineyard sites in Los Lingues in Alto Colchagua, El Crucero in Pamilla, and San Alberto de Peralillo in Parrones.

ABOUT THE WINE

Pale yellow with green tones. Aromas of intense tropical fruits, herbs and notes of citrus. Clean, bright & balanced, with a pleasing acidity and soft persistent finish.
