ABOUT THE WINERY

Founded in 1864, Fenocchio is a 12-hectare estate that has been handed down for over five generations. The winery truly emerged under Giacomo Fenocchio, and is run today by his three sons, Claudio, Albino & Alberto.

The Fenocchio family has two of the most prestigious vineyard sites in Barolo, Cannubi & Bussia. Their Cannubi vineyard was purchased by the family in the late 1800's & is considered to be among the finest. Their Bussia vineyard, in the family since 1867, is known for its powerful & structured wines.

ABOUT THE WINE

Fenocchio's Arneis from the historical Roero zone is has a creamy texture with delightful tropical fruit, floral & chamomile notes. The flavor is pleasantly tangy, full and very persistent. It has a minerality that only the Roero gives and a long, persistent finish.

Varietal(s)	100% Arneis
Vinification	Mid-September harvest. The grapes are gently pressed and then the wine-must obtained is refrigerated in stainless steel vats to allow the lees to settle. After 24-36 hours the juice is separated from the lees and fermented at a controlled temperature. Bottling is done in sterile conditions. Aged in stainless steel tanks and matured in the bottle.
