## About the Producer (Viña Morandé)

Pablo Morandé founded Viña Morandé in 1996. He did it with a great vision for the future and with the same audacity that drove him, years earlier, to be the first person to plant vines in the Casablanca Valley.

Viña Morandé is innovative in the production and marketing of Mediterranean varieties such as Cinsault, Carignan, and Garnacha, in a region where others are solely focused on traditional varieties and old vines.

Their pioneering spirit has always led them to go a step beyond. Some of these innovations are:

- planting of high-density crops to improve quality
- adoption of the enological practice of using concrete eggs
- using the traditional-but-often-forgotten large oak foudres for producing reserve-level wines
- being the first winery in Chile to produce a late harvest wine
- being the first winery in Chile to be recognized as 100% sustainable
