Brothers Mathieu and Benoit Fleuriet have been growing vines at the Domaine since 1991. The estate is located in the hamlet of Vauvise, part of the town of Menetou Ratel. They farm 35 different parcels of around 25 hectares of vineyards (61.7 acres). The vineyards are planted on very distinctive soils: Caillottes, Terres Blanches and Silex.

ABOUT THE WINE

The name "Les demoiselles" (translates as "The young ladies") refers to the beautiful migratory cranes that fly over the town of Sancerre twice a year. These graceful birds offer a unique and impressive show when they sometimes land on the banks of the Loire River. The Fleuriet family wanted to highlight this exceptional grace and express an elegant and refined bouquet in this Sancerre Demoiselles cuvée.

The wine shows a bright yellow color with green highlights, a fruity nose with aromas of white flowers and acacia. Light-medium bodied in the mouth, supple and well structured, its concentration and crisp acidity make it a harmonious and food-friendly wine.
