

Les Gentilhommes Macon-Péronne France - Burgundy - Macon Péronne

This single-vineyard Chardonnay is produced by Richard and Stéphane Martin from Domaine de la Croix Senaillet, in the village of Péronne, in the heart of the Maconnais region in Burgundy, from 40-year-old vines planted on the limestone-based soils of the Mount Epin.

A beautiful golden color with green reflections, delicate toasty notes and attractive aromas of citrus and ripe summer fruits combine with floral and honey nuances that are typical of the old vines.

Fresh, ample, and full-bodied on the palate, the wine is perfect by itself as an aperitif and delicious during the meal.
