## ABOUT THE WINERY

Maipe is a Kysela trademarked wine produced by Casir dos Santos. Founded in 1862, Casir dos Santos is one of the oldest wineries still operating in Argentina. They make wine from the Uco Valley, Lujan de Cuyo and Maipu. The Maipe wines are produced from Casir dos Santos' Lunlunta vineyard in Maipu, which features 13 hectares of old vine Malbec, some over 100 years old. Casir dos Santos wines are made by head winemaker Fernando Ottaviani and world-renowned winemaker and consultant Didier Debono.

## **ABOUT THE WINE**

Maipe means "Lord of the Wind" in Quechua. The Andean people still invoke his name to clear the skies after a heavy rain, or to temper the summer heat.

Maipe Torrontes offers a spring-like nose of fresh white peaches, pears, green apple, green melon and hints of jasmine and rose petals. On the palate, it has a beautiful structure and acidity, along with fruit flavors and plenty of body. Well-balanced, this wine displays a pleasant freshness with citrus notes and a long finish.
