ABOUT CHAKANA

Chakana Winery is located 3,149 feet above sea level at the foothills of the Andes Mountains in Agrelo, Mendoza. It is one of the leading projects among the new generation of winemakers dedicated to the discovery and expression of the Andean diversity of climate and soils. Chakana, who is certified biodynamic, owns 120 hectares of vineyards, spread across sites in Lujan de Cuyo and Valle de Uco.

ABOUT THE WINE

The Nuna vineyard (3,150 ft. elevation) in Agrelo is Chakana's first Demeter certified organic vineyard. 'Nuna' is a Quechuan word meaning "soul of the land."

Showing the smoothness and sweetness typical of Luján de Cuyo reds, this has attractive smoked meat and blackberry aromas, some pepper spice, and well-integrated old oak. An appealing Syrah with good varietal character.
