

2013 PININO Brunello di Montalcino Italy - Toscana - Brunello di Montalcino DOCG

ABOUT THE WINERY

Pinino is located in Tuscany, to the north of the village of Montalcino. The estate was founded in 1874 by Tito Costanti, a notary public in Montalcino. In 2003, the property was purchased by Andrea and Hannes Gamon of Austria and Max and Silvia Hernandez of Spain. "Pinino" is the original name of the winery, which was one of the first members of the Consorzio del Vino Brunello di Montalcino.

The winery is embedded like a natural amphitheater into the beautiful hillside of Montosoli. The vineyards spread over 16.5 hectares (41 acres) and are planted to 100% Sangiovese for their Brunello di Montalcino. 4 hectares are located on the Pinino estate, with a southern exposure and galestro soil. The remaining land is located on the Canchi estate, with a southeastern exposure and soils of clay and limestone.

ABOUT THE WINE

Smooth, round and silky wine with cherry and blueberry aromas, vanilla beans, spice and tobacco nuances. Full-bodied and elegant, well-balanced and a layered palate with dark fruit flavors and a long finish.
