

DOMAINE JEAN REVERDY et Fils Sancerre Rouge Les Villots

France - Loire Valley - Sancerre

ABOUT DOMAINE REVERDY

Domaine Jean Reverdy is located in Verdigny, one of the top villages in Sancerre. The domaine dates back to 1650 and has been in the family for about 10 generations. Owner Christophe Reverdy, son of the late Jean Reverdy, now produces around 100,000 bottles per year on average and exports 70% of the total production.

The domaine spreads over 12 hectares (29.64 acres) - 9 hectares Sauvignon Blanc & 3 hectares Pinot Noir — and produces red, rosé and white wine. Vines are 25+ years old, and the vineyard is divided into 15 parcels located on the hills of Verdigny, Saint Satur, Sancerre and Thauvenay. The soil is a mix of "Terres a Silex" (silicious clay), "Caillottes" (pebbly limestone), and "Terres Blanches", also known as Kimmeridgian marl (white clay & limestone soil).

The Sancerre A.O.C. was created in 1936 for the white wines and in 1959 for the reds. The vineyards of Sancerre measure 2,500 hectares (6,175 acres) total and spreads over 14 communes.

ABOUT THE WINE

100% Pinot Noir from 25+ year old vines. The wine is spicy and juicy with cherry aromas, and proves the point that power is not necessary for a fine wine!
