ABOUT THE WINERY

Azienda Agricola Rinaldi Vini is located on the hills of Alto Monferrato, close to Acqui Terme, in the heart of one of the most precious areas of southern Piedmont. This family business was founded in 1961 by Oreste Rinaldi and is run today by his son, Andrea. The family produces wine from their vineyards located in a particularly desirable area, with a favorable microclimate and a perfect southwestern exposure.

Currently Rinaldi has 20 hectares of vines (50 acres). They produce Moscato, Brachetto, Barbera, Cabernet Sauvignon and Malvasia, with an annual production around 15,000 cases.

ABOUT THE WINE

Celle is the name of the vineyard. While it literally means 'prison', the name comes from a 19^{th} century tradition, in which everyone had small pieces of land – cells – on the best hill.

The wine shows a nice vibrant red color with glints of Bordeaux. It reveals the typical and beautiful intensity of the Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose is spicy, and the palate is smooth and long. Acidity is balanced with sweet tannins and red fruits notes. Velvety and elegant.

Varietal(s)	100% Cabernet Sauvignon from 20 years old vines
Vinification	The end of the alcoholic fermentation takes place in French oak barrels. 4 months oak aging gives it elegance and complexity.
Pairings	Try it with game dishes and strong cheeses.
