Chakana Winery is located 3,149 feet above sea level at the foothills of the Andes Mountains in Agrelo, Mendoza. It is one of the leading projects among the new generation of winemakers dedicated to the discovery and expression of the Andean diversity of climate and soils. Chakana, who is certified biodynamic, owns 120 hectares of vineyards, spread across sites in Lujan de Cuyo and Valle de Uco.

ABOUT THE WINE

Sobrenatural is a new line of certified organic and no Sulphur added wines from Chakana's Nuna vineyard.

Bonarda offers a fresh and fruity nose with blackberry and blackcurrant aromas, herbal notes, good acidity and a bright, juicy texture. Low tannins, excellent freshness and a long finish.
