

WINEMAKER'S NOTE

2019 will be remembered as one of the finest vintages ever for Virginia red wines. September and October were remarkably dry, allowing the fruit to ripen fully. Harvest decisions are often made with respect to rain events or fungal disease pressure – none of which existed in 2019. This is robust wine in the style of Saint-Émilion – delicate yet pure aromas of black cherry and cassis with a backbone of dusty tannins from the fruit and oak barrels.

WINEMAKING

Hand-picked fruit was chilled before processing into fermentation bin and stainless steels tanks. 7-10 day fermentation. Complete malolactic fermentation in barrels.

Black cherry, currant, raspberry, vanilla, earth, tobacco.

CELLARING

18 months in French oak barrels
