ABOUT THE WINERY

Chakana Winery, founded in 2002 by Juan Pelizzatti, is a family owned winery located 960 meters above sea level in the foothills of the Andes Mountains. Wines are made by Gabriel Bloise, who is committed to preserving the true character of the soils and region. Chakana owns 450 hectares of vineyards in Lujan de Cuyo and the Uco Valley, all farmed biodynamically or organically. They produce 150,000 9-liter cases per year.

ABOUT THE WINE

Tiza Malbec is a custom cuvee made for Kysela Pere et Fils. 100% Malbec aged 12 months in new French oak. Biodynamic farming.

Tasting Notes: fresh nose of spring flowers, with mulberry, blackberry & chocolate notes. Subtle spice and superb fruit flavors combine nicely with toasty notes, providing great structure and a long finish.
