ABOUT THE WINERY

Bodega San Gregorio is a cave co-op founded in 1965. It is located in the Ribota River Valley, some 30 kilometers (20 miles) north of the city of Calatayud. It belongs to the Calatayud D.O., created in 1989.

The coop cultivates 2,200 acres of primarily Garnacha (70%) and Tempranillo (20%), with some white Macabeo and other varieties. Most of the vines are at least 40 years old; some over 50 years. The vines, planted "en vaso" (head-trained), are not irrigated, offering very low production levels. Local soils are rich in limestone, marl and slate.

ABOUT THE WINE

Our Tres Ojos – "three eyes" – is named after an ancient walking bridge in the city of Calatayud. The bridge's three arches earned it the nickname 'tres ojos'.



This fresh, crisp and juicy rosé is ½ Garnacha & ½ Tempranillo. It displays beautiful strawberry and raspberry fruits, medium acidity and a refreshing finish.
