#### **TASTING NOTES:**

An aromatic, vibrant and intense white with a pleasant finish. Precise and careful viticulture and a unique blend of native varieties, Treixadura, Godello, Albariño and Torrontés, express the diversity and richness of Ribeiro — one of the most prolific winemaking regions in Spain since the 11th century.

### **TERROIR:**

12 small plots across just 40 acres of land with varying slopes and aspects that allow the grapes to benefit from different sun exposures and that thrive in the "Sábrego" soil: unique to this region and comprised of decomposed granite, sand and clay.

#### WINEMAKING:

Exhaustively hand-harvested according to the optimal ripeness of each bunch then transported in small crates back to the winery where each plot and variety is kept separate for individual fermentation in e either stainless steel, concrete or oak vats.

## AGEING:

10 months on the lees in a combination of stainless steel, concrete, 600L French oak barrels & 1,200L Foudres.
