Winzer Von Erbach Germany – Rheingau

ABOUT WINZER VON ERBACH

Winzer von Erbach's wine growers' organization was founded in 1897. Their cellar was built in 1903 in the "Art Nouveau" style. Today they have 32 vintners who deliver grapes from the Erbach and Rauenthal vineyards to their cellar, and they are the most highly rated wine cooperation in the Rheingau region, known for their high quality Riesling wines with a strong price-value relationship.

Together with the Mosel region, Rheingau is famous for growing top quality Riesling grape. Rheingau is a smaller region, with 3,200 hectares (7,904 acres) in a 45 kilometer stretch from Wiesbaden to Lorchhausen. It is an unequivocally cool area, yielding more elegant & refreshing wines, rather than robust & intense. More than 30% of the Winzer von Erbach's vineyards are located in the top spots of the Rheingau called "erstes Gewächs" (first growth).

ABOUT THE WINE

This southwest-facing vineyard has particularly deep loose-clay and meadow soils. This area's name is derived from the good honey-producing plants that grew on the hill before it was cultivated. They are situated next to the famous Steinberg vineyard at the same altitude level.

The wine is round and refreshing with light touches of lemon and lime on the nose. Slightly sweet mouthfeel, with juicy and fruity flavors.

Varietal(s)	100% Riesling
Vinification	Bottling is done in spring and early summer to preserve the fresh and fruity Riesling character. Because of its pronounced fruity acidity, you can store Rheingau Riesling longer than other white wines, especially when they are sweet (8-25 years and more).
Soil	Loose clay and meadow
Pairings	Fresh garden salad, chicken, spiced Asian food.
