Additional Facts:

- One of the widely recognized Bordeaux Grapes
- dark skinned
- Light to Medium bodied
- Known for Herbaceous accents of tobacco and dark spice
- Methoxypyrazine or Pyrazine chemical, which causes green bell pepper characteristic, produced when grapes are sheltered from the sun or picked under-ripe. Some clones will naturally produce grapes with more bell pepper characteristics.

 Green bell pepper is considered a flaw.
- 30 minutes of decanting will soften Cabernet Franc and increase boldness
- Commonly used as a blending grape
- Loire Valley specializes in Cabernet Franc as a single-varietal
- Parent grape of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Carménère
