

Aged 11 months in neutral American oak barrels, the wine exudes classic ripe blackberry and raspberry flavors with a touch of black pepper spice, a kiss of smoky vanilla oak, and a dash of baking spice. The blend is 84% Zinfandel and 16% Petite Sirah and may be aged 2-4 years. -Vineyard Sources-

The Zinfandel vineyards are located on the hillsides in the scenic and bucolic setting of the historic Dry Creek Valley. This region has long been considered the Mecca for great Zinfandel. The vines are head-pruned and hand-picked from old vine vineyards.

-Technical Information-

-Winemaking-

The winter of 2017 was a wet one giving the grapes a great start. A warm summer boosted flavors and aromatics. An earlier than usual harvest was done the first week of September and the grapes exhibited concentrated fruit and flavor. Temperature controlled fermentation occurred in stainless steel tanks with daily pumpovers to extract color and flavor from the skins. The wine was then aged in neutral American oak barrels for 11 months.

-Tasting Notes-

Zanon Zinfandel is a classic Dry Creek Valley Zin. The wine exudes typical blackberry and raspberry aromas along with a dash of black pepper and warm baking spice. A long elegant finish is framed by a kiss of vanilla oak. The blend is 84% Zinfandel and 16% Petite Sirah which adds color and structure. Enjoy this cork finished Zinfandel now or cellar for 2-4 years.
