Spain - Balearic Islands - Vino de la Tierra de Ibiza

The combination of this genetically Ibicencan Mourvèdre, ungrafted vines, sandy soils and Mediterranean climate results in a juicy red wine with red fruit and violet aromas, a mineral and fresh character, ripe tannins and a long finish.

This 100% Mourvèdre is produced from 5 different parcels of a total surface area of 3.2 Ha planted on sandy soils very close to the sea. All parcels have been farmed ecologically for over 10 years. Ungrafted 60 to 90-year old vines. This results in a wine that is true to its variety while respecting local customs, with a special emphasis on the cultivation process.

Malolactic fermentation in stainless steel deposits and ageing in French-oak barrels. > Ageing: Between 10 and 11 months in 500 L. and 700 L. French-oak barrels of more than one use as well as a 225 L. amphora. pH: 3.59 TA: 4.80 grams/L RS: 2.20 grams/L
