



PALACIO DE BORNOS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2015, GOLD MEDAL IN THE 20TH EDITION OF BERLINER WEIN TROPHY

Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 has been awarded with a Gold Medal at Berliner Wein Trophy, which has celebrated its 20th edition and consolidates as the most important and large international wine contest in Germany.

In this year's edition, 9.500 wines from all over the world have been tasted by an international jury of 185 professional experts following the rules of its two main sponsors: The International Organization of Vine and Wine (OIV, which guarantees that the contest follows the international tasting rules) and the Union Internationale des enologues (UIOE, which represents more than 20.000 professionals coming from more than 12.000 companies and associations all over the world).

Under the above demanding conditions and among all the white wines, Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 was awarded with a Gold Medal in its category, what shows the importance of the acknowledgment for Palacio de Bornos.

Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 is a 100% Sauvignon Blanc coming from 220 hectares of our own vineyards (most of them more than 30 years old) in the villages of Rueda, Pollos and La Seca (Valladolid)



The wine shows an attractive pale bright yellow colour and intense varietal aromas of tropical fruit and herbaceous and mineral hints. It is fresh, fruity, tasty and balanced on the palate with good acidity and a lingering finish.
