











## Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015, awarded with a Gold Medal at Concours Mondial du Sauvignon

Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 has been awarded with a Gold Medal in the 7th edition of the prestigious international contest Concours Mondial du Sauvignon which this year has been celebrated in Rueda (Valladolid) from the 4<sup>th</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of March. During the contest, 901 wines from 24 countries have been tasted by a panel made up of 73 professional experts coming from 24 countries. This year's results were officially presented at Prowein trade fair on March 14<sup>th</sup> in Düsseldorf, Germany.

Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 is a straight Sauvignon Blanc coming from 220 hectares of own vineyards, in the towns of Rueda, Pollos and La Seca (Valladolid).















Our winemaker Pilar García del Pino, explains, "the wine has great personality and it is easy to drink, it shows good aromatic intensity with citric notes and tropical fruit hints. Fresh, lively and well balanced on the palate".

Palacio de Bornos Sauvignon Blanc 2015 has an attractive pale bright yellow colour and intense varietal aromas. It is powerful, elegant, fresh, tasty and balanced on the palate with good acidity and a lingering finish.
