The grapes come from the Premier Cru Champ Gain in Puligny Montrachet, from a small parcel of .47 acre.

Charming and powerful aromas of brioche, green apple and floral blossoms with saline nuances. The mouth is harmonious, complex and well-structured with a mineral character, bright acidity and a long finish.

Vinification	After a static clarification, the grape must is put into French oak barrels (1/3 renewed each year) to start the alcoholic fermentation. It stays in barrels for 15 months. It is slightly filtered before bottling.
Pairings	Frogs’ legs cassalette, Pike Quennelles, Beaufort cheese.
