A deep purple color, powerful and elegant wine with a rich nose, fruit aromas. Well-balanced, powerful yet refined on the palate with present but mellow woody tannins, fruit flavors. Decant for an hour or two before serving so the wine can express its full flavor.

Specifications

Appellation	Bordeaux Superieur
Varietals	70 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 10 % Petit Verdot
Soil type	Loamy clay
Vinification	The grapes are hand-harvested at full maturity. Temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel vats between 28 degrees - 30 degrees C. Only 50 to 75% of the annual production is selected from vats for bottling. Aging in oak casks (20% to 30% new barrels every year).
Pairings	Grilled vegetables and grilled steaks will be a perfect match, but pizza, pasta and hamburger will work very well too !
