Vinification	Drip irrigation is used. And harvesting was done by machine. The grapes are destemmed and crushed into a stainless steel tank. The grapes are not sorted. The fermentation was done using pumpovers. The finished wine was aged in Stainless steel with French oak chips. This blend has 7% Petite Sirah and the balance is Zinfandel. The wine was bottled after 1 year of aging. This wine has an RS 3.3g/l and TA of 6.0g/L
