This wine shows a purple intense color. Aromas are reminiscent of Mediterranean character with blackberry, garrigue, thyme and some herbal spice. The mouthfeel is rich and fresh with some mintiness and a great length to the finish.

The Laugé Family called this new cuvee "Vintage" to highlight both the tradition and modernity in the wine. In French, the word 'tradition' is used to designate old products having a style and excellent quality. They wanted to bring a modern character and an international name, open to the world and understood by all wine lovers.
