2015 SYRAH MOAIC SONOMA COUNTY

WINE NOTES 2015's uncommonly low yields and drought conditions led to an impressively rich, intensely flavored wine with significant body and structure. A Syrah that hearkens to the wild, spice-driven wines of the Northern Rhone.

VINEYARD Sourced from neighboring vineyards located at 1,000 feet on the northwest crown of Sonoma Mountain, whose well-drained soils and exposure to cooling pacific winds lead to early budbreak, followed by long, consistent growing seasons.

WINE SPECTATOR *93pts - Combines brooding intensity with polish, offering spirited blueberry, bittersweet chocolate and smoky licorice flavors that build richness toward broad-shouldered tannins. Best from 2020 through 2025.*
