



2020 SAINTE VICTOIRE Côtes de Provence Rosé

France – Rhône Valley – Sainte Victoire Côtes de Provence AOC

Sainte Victoire Rosé is produced at Château La Galinière, located in the town of Chateauneuf-le-Rouge, just outside Aix-en-Provence. It is the site of a magnificent 18th century château dominating the plains of Cengle. The property, certified organic in France since the 2014 vintage, is located on bauxite-rich clay and sandy red soil.

Since the 2005 vintage, the creation of the Sainte-Victoire Côtes de Provence AOC has allowed the differentiation of its wines from the mass Cotes de Provence AOC. All the plots were analyzed, evaluated and cataloged, and only the best were classified as Sainte-Victoire. The AOC covers over 3,000 hectares and 9 communes, and it applies only to rosé and red wines (white wines retain the appellation Côtes de Provence).

Our Saint Victoire Côtes de Provence rosé is bright, crisp and fruity. Beautifully balanced with a good acidity, it is refreshing and easy to drink.
