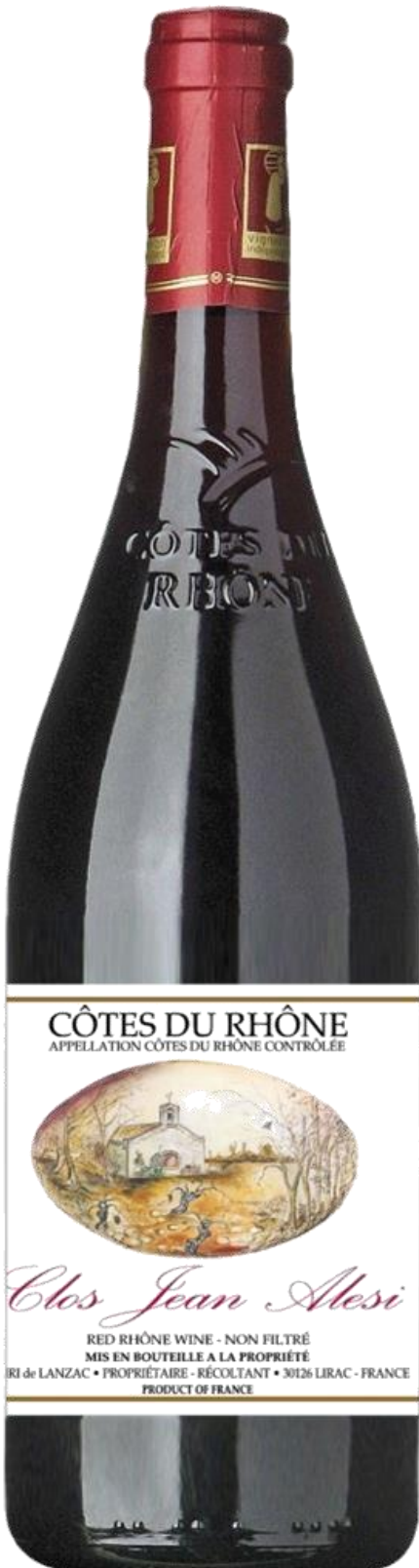




2017 Clos Jean Alesi Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge France – Rhône Valley – Côtes-du-Rhône AOC



ABOUT CLOS JEAN ALESI

Clos Jean Alesi is produced by Château de Ségriès. The 3.9-hectare vineyard, in the famous "Chartreuse district" in Villeneuve-les-Avignon, has been owned by former Formula One driver Jean Alesi since 1995.

This Côtes-du-Rhône AOC comes from 60-year-old vines. Aged in oak barrels for 11 months, the wine displays a dark, frosted garnet color. Concentrated and full-bodied with ripe red fruit & vanilla aromas. A structured and balanced wine with soft, mellow tannins.
