ABOUT THE WINERY

Founded in 2009, Onepiò Winery was established by Ilaria Accordini, who grew up in a winemaking family. 'Piò' is the local term that wine producers use to describe how many hectares they have – three piòs is one hectare. Because the winery's large walls are one third of a hectare in size, Ilaria named her business 'Onepiò'.

Onepiò Winery produces wine from Lugana (30 hectares), Valpolicella Classica (10 hectares) and Bardolino (2 hectares). The Valpolicella Classica vineyards are in Fumane, the oldest original area of Valpolicella, east of Lake Garda and a few kilometers from the center of Verona.

ABOUT THE WINE

Amarone is called the king of the Italian wines and it is considered as one of the best wines in the world. It is a noble and complex wine. In the Valpolicella area, the Lessini hills protect the vineyards from cold fronts from the north, and by Garda Lake from the west, creating ideal temperature control during the winter months.

Amarone is a noble wine with a unique and different personality from year to year. A great character and personality, the wine boasts an intense garnet color, black cherry and raspberry aromas, spicy notes, coffee and liquorice. The mouth is full and persistent, soft and smooth with a good structure.
