### ABOUT THE WINERY

Maípe is a Kyselá trademarked wine produced by Casir dos Santos. Founded in 1862, Casir dos Santos is one of the oldest wineries still operating in Argentina. They make wine from the Uco Valley, Lujan de Cuyo and Maipu. The Maípe wines are produced from Casir dos Santos' Lunlunta vineyard in Maipu, which features 13 hectares of old vine Malbec, some over 100 years old. Casir dos Santos wines are made by head winemaker Fernando Ottaviani and world-renowned winemaker and consultant Didier Debono.

### ABOUT THE WINE

Maípe means "Lord of the Wind" in Quechua. The Andean people still invoke his name to clear the skies after a heavy rain, or to temper the summer heat.

This Cabernet Sauvignon has an intense ruby red color with aromas and flavors of ripe blackcurrant, red pepper, mint, chocolate and vanilla hints. The fruit and tannins are perfectly balanced to produce a wine of excellent structure.
