

Pernot Belicard Meursault Vieilles Vignes

Domaine Pernot Belicard

France - Burgundy - Meursault

The wine is produced from old vines Chardonnay coming from a small parcel of 1.63 acres in the village of Meursault.

This wine offers stone fruit aromas on the nose combined with tropical fruit notes and a hint of toasted oak. The mouth is wide and rich. Complex and textured, bright acidity, a good tension that brings length and balance to the wine that finishes on mineral and citrus fruits.

Age of Vines	Between 50 and 75 years old
Agricultural Practices	Sustainable
Soil type	well-drained clay-limestone composed of Jurassic limestone screes
Vinification	After a static clarification, the grape must is put into French oak barrels (1/3 renewed each year) to start the alcoholic fermentation. It stays in barrels for 13 months. It is slightly filtered before bottling.
Pairings	Ham with Epoisse cream, Burgundy Snails, Pyrénées sheep's milk cheese.
