

Thomas Sancerre Blanc Silex

Domaine Michel Thomas

France - Loire Valley - Sancerre

The special bottling "Silex" is limited each year to 400-500 cases. The vines of Michel Thomas cover three types of soil, with Le Roc-Silex being the hardest stone soil of the vineyard, and the sole source for this wine. The siliceous soil imparts pleasant notes of fruit and a dry, smoky, mineral flavor. This wine is bottled using traditional methods without filtration, allowing for an authentic and natural taste.

Intensely aromatic and concentrated Sauvignon, this is a wine of great concentration and excellent balance. Aromas of fresh herbs, with flavors of citrus, ripe gooseberry, apple and a hint of gunflint.

Vinification	The grapes are grown on three soil types: 40% Terre Blanche-Argilo-Calcaire, 40% Caillottes-calcaire, 20% Le Roc-Silex. This wine comes from the hardest stone soil on the vineyard giving it pleasant notes of fruit and a very dry flavor: This wine is bottled using traditional methods without filtration, allowing for a authentic and natural taste to the wine.
