On the palate, fine and concentrated tannins are balanced by a nice salinity. Delicious peppery notes complete the long finish.

Varietals	85% Grenache and 15% Mourvèdre
Age of Vines	Average 800-100 years old
Agricultural Practices	Sustainable
Soil type	42 altitude parcels located mainly on terraces near the Dentelles de Montmirail.
Vinification	100% destemmed. Hand harvesting with parcel sorting. Cold start fermentation to favor the soft diffusion of tannins and aromatic compounds without extraction of vegetal aromas. The grapes are co-fermented in tanks and, after malolactic fermentation, aged in tronconiques wooden vats .
Production	600 (9-liter cases)
Pairings	Grilled lamb - Roasted Quails with raisins -Venison with cranberries - Risotto with mushrooms.
